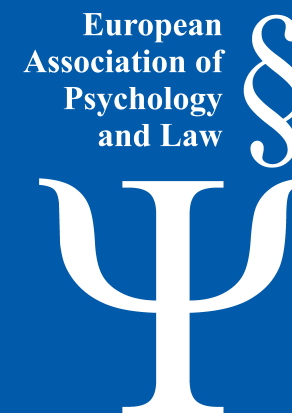

FEATURES OF THE CONFERENCE

The conference main program includes:

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

The deadline for submission of abstracts is January 20, 2009.

All abstracts should be submitted online by filling in the abstract form. Abstracts should not exceed 150 words. English is the official language and will be adopted in all the publications and presentations. Proposals for oral or poster presentations are considered. The Scientific Committee will review all abstracts. In some cases abstracts can be rejected as oral presentations but accepted as posters. The first author on the abstract is considered to be the presenter of the paper at the conference. Applicants will receive notification of acceptance no later than February 28, 2009.

SUBMISSION OF SYMPOSIA

A symposium is a collection of related presentations. The Scientific Committee invites participants to propose symposia for the 2009 EAPL Conference. The person submitting the symposium proposal is the symposium coordinator. He/she is asked to submit an integrated summary of the goals and objectives of the symposium plus four or five abstracts of the individual contributions. Symposium proposals should not exceed 500 words. Symposium coordinators are encouraged to strive for international diversity amongst the different abstracts.
